Waste Electric and Electronic Equipment Recycling Policy

Policy Statement of Intent

Aird Walker & Ralston Limited are committed to the disposal off and or recycling of electrical and electronic equipment used within our products and service, whilst complying with statutory and regulatory requirements. We are fully aware of our responsibilities contained within the Waste Electric and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2013 and will comply with the legislation at all times. Further to investigations into our obligations under the WEEE Directive, it is our understanding that the equipment we produce (including control panels) is covered by some of the justifiable exemptions within the directive and therefore the company will not be responsible for the end of use disposal. Should any of our equipment fall outside these exemptions, Aird Walker & Ralston Ltd will ensure compliance with the Directive. The exemptions within the Directive that are relevant to Aird Walker & Ralston Limited are as follows:

Fixed installations

A control panel is vital to any fixed installation for which they are to be incorporated. The function of the installation could not be performed without the control panel being installed.

Stationary industrial tools

A control panel is an essential component of any large scale stationary industrial tool, such as fixed machinery or plant. The equipment would not function without the control panel being installed. The panel is therefore incorporated as part of the large scale stationary industrial tool, or the equipment could be deemed as a fixed installation (as above).

Equipment that is part of another type of equipment that is not within the scope of the Directive

This is generally used for items such as motor vehicles, but as previously indicated, control panels are a part of fixed installations and large scale stationary industrial tools, which are exclusions from the Directive. Should Aird Walker & Ralston Limited be requested to remove and dispose of redundant equipment, under a commercial agreement, we are prepared to do so and will ensure that all documentation (Waste Carrier Licence, Transfer Note, Consignment Note etc.) is supplied, ensuring the correct transportation and disposal.

Statement on the RoHS Directive (Restriction of Hazardous Substances Regulations) 2002/95/EC

Aird Walker & Ralston Ltd are fully aware of our responsibilities contained within the ROHS Directive and will comply with the legislation at all times.

We assemble control panels from equipment supplied to us and will ensure that these suppliers also comply with the ROHS Directive and with the current legislation.

It is the ultimate responsibility of the directors for overseeing the implementation of this Policy, which is reviewed annually or sooner in the event of any change in legislation or procedure affecting the policy.
